## REQUIREMENTS FOR ABSTRACTS:

- Volume – 2-5 pages. A-4 format in the text editor Microsoft Word for Windows 6.0, 7.0, 97, 2000, 2003, 2007; type - Times New Roman, size - 14; line spacing - 1.5; paragraph indent- 1.25 cm; margins - 2 cm;
- The sequence of materials in the abstracts: the direction of the conference in accordance with the theme of the report (for example, Direction 1. Theory and history of state and law; history of political and legal scholars), the title of theses (type - bold); surname and initials of the author(s) (type - bold); scientific degree, academic title (if any), position, place of work (study); the city where the educational institution is located, the country; text;
- The name of the file must be signed in English according to the surname and initials of the conference participant, and in case of co-authorship - the surname of the first author (for example, Smith. M.\_abstracts);
- The references (without repetitions) is made out at the end of the text according to requirements of the National standard of Ukraine DSTU 8302:2015 “Information and documentation. Bibliographic link. General provisions and rules of compilation” entitled “Literature:”. In the text, footnotes are indicated by square brackets indicating the ordinal number of the source in the list and a comma - page numbers (pages), for example: [1, p. 45].
