2. Requirements for the publication of the monograph section:

2.1. Volume - 20-24 pages (size 14, Times New Roman, interval - 1.5). Top, bottom, left, right margins - 20 mm.

The text is typed without hyphenation, in the full width of the page. Pages are not numbered.

Use paired quotation marks (« »).

When typing, distinguish between hyphens and dashes. It is forbidden to tabulate a paragraph (use a ruler).

2.2. The formulas (if any) are centred, numbered and typed in the Microsoft Equation editor. For example:

$$\Omega = (E, X, R, P, \Lambda, I, \lambda) \tag{1}$$

2.3. Tables should have a heading placed above the table.

The heading and text of the table should be formatted as follows: 11pt, centre (Table 1).

2.4. Each figure must be signed. The caption (title) of the figure should be written: 11pt, centre (Fig. 1).

- 2.5. When referring to graphical objects in the text, use the following notation:
- formula (1), (1, 2); table (Table 1), (Table 1, 2); figure (Fig. 1), (Fig. 1, 2).
- 2.6. An unbroken space between the initials of the persons is required (simultaneously hold down Ctrl + Shift + Space)!
- 2.7. The abstract in English should be at least 500 characters long.
- 2.8. Articles and information about the author should be sent in one file, signed by the author's name (for example, Ivanenko.rtf or Ivanenko.doc).
- 2.9.Information about the author(s): surname, name, patronymic, academic degree, academic title, contact phone numbers, e-mail, ORCID, if available Scopus Web of Science identifiers, personal photo of the author(s).

Single author monographic sections are welcome. If necessary, no more than one co-author is allowed in a monographic section (information about the co-author is provided in full with a personal photo), and, if necessary, gratitude is expressed to all those who contributed to the quality of the section's materials or the preparation of the research results presented in the article.

2.10. Information about the author should be provided in two languages - Ukrainian and English (please fill in all the items in this order; not in a table format):
