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#### **Recommended sections of a scientific article:**

1. **Abstract.** The abstract highlights main points of the article.
2. **Introduction.** A problem statement in general terms and its relation to important scientific or practical tasks; an objective statement (task setting).
3. **Literature review.** Actual scientific researches and issues analysis reveals the grounds for a solution to this problem the author has relied on and defines uninvestigated parts of general matters addressed in the article.
4. **Research methodology.**
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## **FORMATTING YOUR ARTICLE**

The materials are accepted in electronic form (MS WORD).

The file name of the article should contain the **last name of the author**.

A **photograph of the author** should be sent separately with the size of 3x4 in JPEG format.

Text formatting: A-4 sheet size (210x297 mm), left margin is 30 mm, right - 15 mm, upper and lower - 25 mm, font size - 14pt, spacing - 1.5, font - Verdana.

The article should contain at least 0.5 printed sheets. (8-12 pages).

### ***The materials should be organized in the sequence:***

- ✓ full name of the author(s) (right-aligned independent section);
- ✓ academic rank, academic degree, position (right-aligned independent section);
- ✓ place of work: name of institution, place name (if not included in name of institution) (right-aligned independent section);
- ✓ country (right-aligned independent section);
- ✓ personal e-mail address (right-aligned separate section);
- ✓ ORCID iD (right-aligned independent section);
- ✓ title of the article (bold type, uppercase, separate flush paragraph, center alignment, single spacing);
- ✓ abstract (Word – 2003 Verdana 12pt, 1.5 spacing).

*The abstract highlights main points of the article. It should be written according to the following algorithm: the relevance of the topic chosen for research by the author is revealed in two-three sentences; the research objective and subject are specified; the methodology (method) of the research (its theoretical basis for a fundamental research) is revealed; the obtained results and its practical value are characterized. In so doing, each point should logically follow from the foregoing.*

*Quantitative results are preferable in the abstract of a research article; it is possible not to give results, but indicate the considered issues in a review. The abstract should not contain references. The abstract text should be concise and original. The abstract should not contain sentences from the body of the article, but it also should not include material that does not appear in the article. A volume is 600-700 characters.*

- ✓ keywords (5-10 words) (bold type, separate section);
- ✓ text of the article (Word – 2003 Verdana 14pt, 1,5 spacing);
- ✓ references are and formatted according to Harvard Referencing Style.

*The references are not numbered, but ordered alphabetically by author and chronologically when references are made to more than one work of the author (by year of a publication starting with the earliest). If there are works of one author published in the same year, they are placed in alphabetical order in the bibliographic list based on the titles of the works; in this case, the small Latin letter a, b, c... should be added to the year of publication.*

*A quotation is placed within quotation marks "...", the reference is added in parentheses, example: (Jones, 1967, p.27).*

### Formatting references:

A reference indicates all authors of the work, if authors are not available, then the editors are specified. If there are many authors, it can be written "et al." after a few names. Titles of books and journals are indicated without abbreviations. A title of the book, article, dissertation or author's abstract and a name of the invention should include its transliteration into English in square brackets. Example: Systematychna Teolohiia [Systematic Theology].




Fig. 1. The paradox is the need for a combination of state and market regulation of the functioning of the agricultural sector of the economy

An article is accepted for publication when originality of the text has been determined and the article has been peer-reviewed by independent experts the author(s) is (are) informed about.

Articles are accepted for publication by an author and co-authors (a maximum of two co-authors).
